



Senior Community Service Experience Program

Students will be required to complete and document 15 hours of community service experience by April 30, 2022. All students MUST complete their Senior Community Service Experience as one of the requirements in order to receive their Certificate of Completion. The period acceptable for the Senior Community Service Experience Program begins June 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.

- ▶ Cannot to be completed for relatives
- ▶ Must be completed without pay
- ▶ Cannot be completed during school hours

- ✓ Visit a nursing home and read to or help the elderly residents
- ✓ Volunteer at the Humane Society
- ✓ Do yard work or other home maintenance for an elderly neighbor
- ✓ Run errands, such as grocery store, for an elderly neighbor
- ✓ Volunteer to help with community events, such as First Friday's Community Events, Ham Convention, Local Festivals
- ✓ Volunteer with Parks and Recreation, or City Maintenance
- ✓ Adopt a street or river bank to keep clean
- ✓ Provide tutoring help for other students after school in Student Enrichment
- ✓ Volunteer at local churches, food pantries, fire departments
- ✓ Volunteer with local Veteran Affairs
- ✓ Provide unpaid help with the maintenance departments of local schools
- ✓ Red Cross, Cancer Society, Habitat for Humanity, Heart Association, Special Olympics, 4 Paws for Ability, Goodwill Organization, United Way
- ✓ Offer to pet-sit without pay for a neighbor while they are away
- ✓ Organize a yard sale for charity
- ✓ Coach a local youth team
- ✓ Fix and serve meals for elderly or others in need
- ✓ Volunteer at local hospitals
