GCCC Funds	The Greene County Career Center will use \$231,718.20 in Student Wellness and Success Funds and \$47,410.60 in DPIA.
Purpose of Funds	GCCC uses the Disadvantaged Pupil Impact Aid and Student Wellness and Success Funds to provide services to help students break down barriers to learning and access to education. GCCC focuses on the mental and physical health of students through staff and local partners. Districts must prioritize students' physical and mental health needs through community partnerships.
Use of Funds	The Greene County Career Center uses these funds to allocate counseling services for mental health resources to enhance students' emotional well-being. These funds are also used to support our social emotional learning curriculum through the Core Project where staff members provide teachings and interventions to students.
Student Impact	Greene County Career Center serves over one hundred fifty students with in house and community mental health supports and over eight hundred students with social emotional learning. These funds provide financial or emergency assistance to students facing economic hardship, ensuring they can cover essential needs in educational materials, and fundamental basic needs. These funds also help us develop initiatives promoting physical health, academic supports, career development of all students, and accessibility services to help students who are English as a second language learners.
