

SENIOR COMMUNITY EXPERIENCE GUIDELINES

Effective beginning July 1, 2015 and due by May 2, 2016

- Senior Community Experience is **not to be completed for relatives.**
- Senior Community Experience **must be completed without pay.**
- Senior Community Experience should **not be completed during school hours unless requested by an administrator.**
- Senior Community Experience hours cannot be counted towards program certificates.
- Suggestions of experience include:
 - Visit a nursing home and read to an elderly or to help
 - Call the local Humane Society and offer to help them
 - Ask an elderly neighbor if you could do yard work for them
 - Ask an elderly neighbor if they would like for you to go to the store for them
 - Call the local Parks & Recreations and see if they could use your help
 - Call your local City Maintenance to help groom graveyards
 - A group of students get together and adopt a mile of street in your neighborhood or a river bank and clean it several times (adult authority must sign off)
 - Offer tutorial experiences to other students after school. See Mr. Wilson in the Enrichment Room to implement this
 - If you are a member of a church, call and volunteer to help
 - Call the local Veterans Administration and volunteer to help
 - Call your local fire department and volunteer to help
 - Offer to go to neighbor's house and check on their pets regularly while they are on vacation
 - Call local Maintenance Departments of your local school and volunteer to help
 - Call United Way and volunteer to help
 - Call Red Cross and volunteer to help
 - Greene County American Cancer Society Relay for Life Event
 - Free Clothing Store in Fairborn
 - Habitat for Humanity
 - Walk-a-thons/Marathons for Heart Associations
 - 4-Paws for Ability

- Babysitting will not be permitted as a community service project unless preapproved by an administrator.
